Overview and objectives

The POWER programme aims to contribute to a stronger, more inclusive women rights movement in Liberia working more effectively, strategically and sustainability to push for girls and women's rights and empowerment, including the opportunity and capacity to participate qualitatively in decision-making at different levels and in different spaces, decrease gender-based violence, improve access to SRHR services and information, and strengthen their economic empowerment. The integrated thematic approach will link and align women's economic empowerment with women's political participation; gender-based violence programs with sexual and reproductive health and rights (SRHR) to improve service delivery through information sharing and advocacy.




Figure 1: Organisations supported by KtK

The program will prioritise SRHR as crucial to women's health and security, as well as involve youth and LGBTIQ+ organizations to achieve the following outcomes:

- KtK contributes to a more effective, resilient, and visible women's movement in Liberia.
- KtK's partner organisations contribute to women's meaningful political participation at the local and national level
- KtK's partner organisations contribute to improved protection, prevention and response to Gender Based Violence and access to Sexual and Reproductive Health and Rights
- KtK's partner organisations contribute to promoting women's economic empowerment in targeted locations

Activities

Under the new program, KtK will support ten organizations. Five of the ten organizations are current partners of KtK.
